Graft Wine Company and Portland Restaurant are hosting a very special **Vintelooper wine dinner on 28th January** to raise funds for the Adelaide Hills producers devastated by the bushfires that hit the region before Christmas.

Vintelooper was set up by winemaker David Bowley in 2008 as a nomadic producer, sourcing grapes and sharing cellar space, running legendary urban winery pop-ups across Australia and winning many awards - including the Pinot Palooza People's Choice for best Pinot Noir in Australia & New Zealand

In 2018, after a decade of wandering, David and his team found a vineyard to call home in Cudlee Creek.

This year was due to be their first harvest, but the entire property was razed by the fires. It's believed that as much as a third of the entire region's vines have been destroyed. It will take years to rebuild what has been lost, for Vintelooper and many other producers, in this one of Australia's most dynamic, quality wine regions.
